Workpods– General Care & Maintenance Instructions

Our Workpods are built to last, and with a little help from you, they will stay strong and clean for years to come. Here are some tips:

- Preserve its condition by keeping the relative humidity level in the environment between 30% and 40%.
- Place it away from heat sources such as radiators, heating vents, and wood-burning stoves.
- Shield your furniture from direct sunlight exposure and extreme temperatures to keep the finish pristine.
- Place protective mats or carpets on high-traffic areas to minimize wear.
- Use a damp cloth with mild soap to clean the surfaces.
- Use a soft broom, vacuum cleaner, or microfiber cloth to remove dust and debris after every use.
- Lift and move heavy objects instead of dragging them to prevent scratches or gouges.
- Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that can damage finishes or cause discoloration.
- Use dust covers or tarps to shield from dirt and moisture.

STAIN REMOVAL

- For stubborn stains, sprinkle baking soda directly on the stain and scrub gently with a damp soft-bristled brush or sponge.

WHAT TO AVOID

- Avoid using abrasive cleaners or scrubbers, as they can scratch the plastic surface.

EXTRA CARE

- For outdoor use, hose the table down for an initial rinse before applying the cleaning solution.

PROTECT THE SURFACE

- Using tablecloths or placemats during meals or activities can help prevent scratches, stains, and other damage.
